

WheelTalk fact sheet

About

The WheelTalk inclusion awareness program is an initiative of Disability Sport & Recreation. It encourages students to think about diversity, acceptance and disability – with a primary focus on inclusion.

Presented by Victorians with disability who are actively involved in sport and recreation, WheelTalk combines unique stories of lived disability with the opportunity to play up to an hour of an invasion game – either AFL Wheelchair or wheelchair basketball. All equipment is provided.

WheelTalk sessions run for approximately 1.5 hours and can accommodate up to 30 students.

Venue

WheelTalk is ideally held on an indoor basketball court. Please contact us if you need help finding an appropriate venue. It is very important that you can provide an accessible parking space for a car **and trailer**, close to where the session will take place.

Inclusion

WheelTalk is a program that focuses on inclusion and, as such, we would prefer it if all students were able to take part. If you have students experiencing financial hardship, we encourage you to check whether they are eligible to apply for the [Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund](#).

Pricing

- \$399 for the first session, Monday-Friday.
- \$140 for every additional session on the same day.
- If there is a break of more than one hour between sessions, there is an extra fee of \$140 to cover the presenter's costs.

Note that:

- The first session booked on subsequent days will cost \$399.
- There will be an extra fee for schools that are more than 70km from our Fitzroy office and/or if overnight accommodation is required. Please contact us to discuss details.

All bookings will incur 10% GST. The pricing outlined above does NOT include GST.

We will send you an invoice at the beginning of the month that your WheelTalk session is scheduled for. Our payment terms are 14 days.



Cancellations

We require at least 48 hours' notice if you want to cancel or reschedule your WheelTalk booking. If you give us less than 48 hours' notice, you will be charged the full fee.

If you want to hold your WheelTalk session outside, we are not liable for cancellations due to wet weather. We recommend you plan for your session to be held indoors to avoid being charged the full fee in the event of wet weather.
